

What is Access and Support?

Help for people with disability:

- For hard to reach communities or locations;
- For those who haven't engaged with the NDIS or disability previously;
- Provide short term help to all people with disability of any age, and their carers;
- For those who have diverse needs;
- To remove barriers to access the NDIS or other mainstream services.

Who is it for?

If you are, or caring for someone who is:

- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander;
- Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD);
- Live in a community of less than 5,000 people;
- Financially disadvantaged; or
- Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Intersex, Queer (LGBTIQ).
